SC takes note of letter seeking 'martyr' status for Covid warriors

IN RESPONSE to a letter highlighting the issue of the right to dignity after death, the Supreme Court has taken cognizance of the communication seeking recognition of "martyr" status for "Covid-19 warriors" who die of the viral infection.

Lawyer Manjunath Kakkalameeli, who practises in Bombay High Court and district court of Solapur, had written to the Chief Justice of India, highlighting the issue of frontline workers, such as healthcare professionals and police personnel, being treated as "deaths due to Covid-19" after succumbing to the infection.

"The Supreme Court has taken cognizance of my letter and converted it into a PIL. The hearing will be held soon," Kakkalameeli said.

"We all are safe because Covid warriors, healthcare professionals and police personnel, are fighting on the frontline. In such a situation, it is at most the duty of the

state government and every citizen to honour, respect, and recognise their effort and sacrifice," he said.

He also said no state was respectful of their "sacrifice", and that merely announcing compensation to kin was not only insufficient but "unjust". They deserve respect after death and should be declared "martyrs", he added.

The lawyer said after death, neither did Covid warriors receive state cremation, burial, or funeral nor were they awarded martyr status, while pointing out that the Republic of China awarded a doctor, Li Wenliang, as "martyr". Also, the Odisha government on April 22 had declared that health workers and support service providers, who die of Covid-19 in the line of duty under formal deployment by the state, would get martyr status and a state funeral will be ensured for them along with full salary to their kin.

Kakkalameeli added that to motivate them, it was the duty of the state to honour and recognise the "unparalleled sacrifice" of Covid warriors.

Nagpur records 1,036 new Covid cases, highest single-day spike

CASES OF coronavirus infection continue to surge in Nagpur district, with the daily count of new cases crossing 1,000 for the first time on Friday, which also recorded 27 deaths.

The district reported 1,036 new Covid-19 cases — 169 from rural areas and 867 from within city limits — on Friday, taking the total case tally to 12,745. Of these, 911 cases were from city areas while 239 were from outside the district.

The death toll reached 447 on Friday, of which 321 deaths have

taken place in August alone. As many as 316 deaths have been reported from the city, 73 from rural areas and 58 from outside the district. The overall case tally of Vidarbha was 26,528 till Thursday, almost double of the region's figure in July, 14,334. The death toll in the region also crossed the 800 mark on Friday.

The recovery rate has also been falling in Nagpur district, with only 123 patients being discharged on Friday. So far, 5,639 people have recovered in the district, taking the recovery rate to about 44 per cent, which is way below the national and state average. The mortality rate has also gone up to 3.5 per cent.



Commemorating the nation's independence from 200-year-long British rule, India celebrates its 74th Independence Day this year. In his monthly radio programme Mann Ki Baat, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said Independence Day had to be celebrated in a different way this year. "Pledge to free the nation from Covid-19 this Independence Day," PM Modi said, while also inviting people to share "inspiring anecdotes" of collective efforts which brought about positive changes in other's lives.

"This year, August 15 celebrations too will be in very different circumstances - in the midst of the coronavirus pandemic. I urge the youth, the people of my country to take a pledge of freedom from the pandemic this Independence Day. Take a resolve for a self-reliant India, a resolve to learn and teach something new and a resolve to earnestly carry out our duties," PM Modi said while addressing the nation through his monthly radio programme, Mann Ki Baat.

The clarion call given by the PM to use these trying times to become Atmanirbhar (self-reliant) has been very well received to enable the resurgence of the Indian economy. India has faced the

Covid-19 situation with fortitude and a spirit of self-reliance, that is evident in the fact that from zero production of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) before March 2020, India today has created a capacity of producing two lakh PPE kits daily, which is also growing steadily.

Additionally, the country has demonstrated how it rises up to challenges and uncovers opportunities therein, as manifested in the re-purposing of various automobile sector industries to collaborate in the making of life-saving ventilators.

This year, India also okayed a new National Education Policy (NEP) after 34 years, and so, sweeping changes are set to be introduced in both school and higher education.
