Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. GOIW-12/88 dated 7th January, 1988 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the Environment Department of the State Government has no objection from the environmental angle to permit you to manufacture of -

(i) Weak Nitric Acid	... 600 MTPD
(ii) Concentrated Nitric Acid	... 100 MTPD
(iii) Ammonium Nitrophosphate	... 765 MTPD
(iv) Low Density Prilled Ammonium Nitrate	... 120 MTPD
(v) Methanol	... 300 MTPD

subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The industry will provide a separate pipeline for the discharge of treated effluents. The work shall be completed before commissioning of new products. The point of discharge will be the same as that finalised by M.I.D.C. for its proposed effluent disposal pipeline.
- (ii) The industry will obtain the approval from Chief Controller of Explosives for storage of chemicals such as methanol, ammonium nitrate etc.,
- (iii) The terms and conditions stipulated by the MPCB in its consent order should be strictly complied and inform the compliance of these conditions before commencement of production to MPCB.
- (iv) Tree plantation programme should be undertaken as indicated in the consent letter granted by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, on the factory land, in consultation with the Forest Department of the State Government.
